

**RESOLUTION 2018- 5**  
**Vermillion County Council**

**RESOLUTION REGARDING PROCEDURES TO REQUEST  
DISBURSEMENT OF LOCAL INCOME TAX FOR PUBLIC SAFETY**

WHEREAS, Vermillion County receives Local Income Tax funds to be used for public safety in accordance with I.C. 6-3.6 et seq.; and

WHEREAS, the Vermillion County Council wishes to set forth procedures for governmental entities and public safety volunteer organizations located within the county, who are not otherwise entitled to a Local Income Tax distribution under I.C. 6-3.6-6-8(b), to request, from the County and taken from the County's share, Local Income Tax money collected for the years 2019 and beyond;


NOW, THEREFORE, be it RESOLVED by the Vermillion County Council that:

1. Any governmental entity or public safety volunteer organization not otherwise entitled to a distribution under I.C. 6-3.6-6-8(b) may submit an application requesting funds to be used for public safety purposes as defined by I.C. 6-3.6-2-14.
2. Said application shall be available upon request at the Vermillion County Auditor's Office.
3. In addition to all other information and documents requested in the application, each entity or organization requesting funds shall provide financial balances as of December 31<sup>st</sup>, the prior tax year, a copy of their current budget, and a copy of any Standard Operating Procedures and/or Guidelines that pertain to their intended use of the funds.
4. Any funding to a volunteer organization shall be distributed and administered through a local, sponsoring governmental entity who benefits from the volunteer organization. Said governmental entity shall act as the fiscal agent of the volunteer organization and be responsible for ensuring that all expenses qualify as public safety expenses and accounting for all funds received.
5. All applications shall be due to the Vermillion County Auditor by 4:00 p.m. on June 1, 2018, or the first business day thereafter should this date fall on the weekend. Incomplete applications will not be accepted and no deadline extensions will be allowed.
6. After consideration of each application, it is within the sole discretion of the Vermillion County Council to approve funding, in whole or in part, or to deny funding.

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
  
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
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
