

Ordinance No. 2011- 2
BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF VERMILLION COUNTY, INDIANA

WHEREAS, I.C. 8-17-1-40 provides that a county legislative body may adopt ordinances regulating traffic on any highway in the county highway system, subject to I.C. 9-21:

WHEREAS, I.C. 9-20-1-3 provides that local authorities, with respect to highways under their jurisdiction may by ordinance:

- (1) Prohibit the operation of vehicles upon any highway; or
- (2) Impose restrictions as to the weights of vehicles to be operated upon any highway;

For a total period not to exceed ninety (90) days in any one year whenever any highway by reason of deterioration, rain, snow, or other climate conditions will be seriously damaged or destroyed without the regulation of vehicles.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF VERMILLION COUNTY, INDIANA:


Section 1. A temporary local limit of fifteen (15) tons shall become effective January 1st of each year and ending April 1st of each year. Said local limit shall apply to all bituminous county roads located in Vermillion County, Indiana. This ordinance shall apply to all vehicles except those exempted under I.C. 9-20-2-1 et seq.


Section 2. A temporary permit to operate a vehicle in excess of the load limit set forth in section 1 may be granted if the petitioner has met the requirement for posting of bond in the amount of \$50,000.00 per each mile or any portion thereof, with said bond being payable to the Vermillion County Board of Commissioners. Said bond shall be for the purpose of restoring the Right-of-Way or Apparent Right-of-Way to its original condition with the petitioner guaranteeing the repair work for a period of one year after the date of acceptance by the Vermillion County Board of Commissioners.


Section 3. This ordinance is effective upon passage and signing by the presiding officer and publication as required by law.
