ORDINANCE NO. 2011 - 3

BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF VERMILLION COUNTY, INDIANA

WHEREAS, I.C. 8-17-1-40 provides that a county legislative body may adopt ordinances regulating traffic on any highway in the county highway system, subject to I.C. 9-21;

WHEREAS, I.C. 9-20-1-3 provides that local authorities, with respect to highways under their jurisdiction may by ordinance:

- (1) Prohibit the operation of vehicles upon any highway; or
- (2) Impose restrictions as to the weights of vehicles to be operated upon any highway;

for a total period not to exceed ninety (90) days in any one year whenever any highway by reason of deterioration, rain, snow, or other climate conditions will be seriously damaged or destroyed without the regulation of vehicles.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF VERMILLION COUNTY, INDIANA:

- Section 1. A temporary local limit of fifteen (15) tons shall become effective beginning January 1, 2011 to April 15th until further notice. Limit shall apply to all gravel and bituminous county roads located in Vermillion County, Indiana. This ordinance shall apply to all vehicles except those exempted under I.C. 9-20-2-1-et seq. and school buses when they are being used to transport students or being taken to and from their regular places of storage and maintenance.
- Section 2. This ordinance is effective upon passage and signing by the presiding office and publication as required by law.

Section 3. Violations of this ordinance are subject to \$500 fine.
