## Resolution No. <u>2015-004</u> Vermillion County Board of Commissioners

## A Resolution Involving Baker Lane

Whereas it has come to the attention of the Board of Commissioners of Vermillion County that there exists within the County a private road known as Baker Lane, the Board of Commissioners of Vermillion County resolves as follows:

- 1. That there are residences on Baker Lane which from time to time require school busses, ambulances, police cars and fire trucks to travel down that road in order to provide services to the people that live there.
- 2. That from time to time the road becomes impassible due to snow, ice, fallen trees or other similar occurrences that would prevent an emergency vehicle from responding to a call for service at one of the houses on that road.
- 3. That no mechanism currently exists to clear Baker Lane should it become blocked to emergency vehicles.
- 4. That the Board of Commissioners of Vermillion County finds that from time to time it may be necessary for the safety of the residents of that area that the county send personnel and equipment onto Baker Lane for the purpose of keeping the roadway open and allowing access by emergency vehicles, school busses and similar vehicles.
- 5. That the County is not undertaking responsibility for road maintenance, ditching, right of ways or for any other purpose doing anything beyond resolving to keep the road passable to the extent that they deem it is necessary and beneficial to the residents of the county to do so.
