Ordinance 2017-___003 AMENDMENT TO ORDINANCE 2007-004

Ordinance 2007-004, which was enacted pursuant to I.C. 36-2-13-15 (c), provides that the funds collected by the Sheriff pursuant to the ordinance shall be deposited with the Office of the Clerk of Vermillion County.

However, thereafter the Clerk is depositing the monies to the general fund. The ordinance provides that the funds are to be deposited in fund #513, the Vermillion County Incarceration Fee Fund.

I.C. 36-2-13-15 is silent as to where the monies collected by the Sheriff are to be deposited.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE VERMILLION COUNTY COUNCIL OF VERMILLION COUNTY INDIANA: Section #4 of Ordinance 2007-004 is hereby amended as follows:

"If, and when, the Court assesses fees and/or expenses as provided by this Ordinance, it shall incorporate the same into the Court's Judgment of Conviction, or subsequent Sentence Modification Order. The same shall be reduced to judgment in favor of Vermillion County and against the Defendant. All monies collected as a result of the imposition of this fee shall be paid into the Office of the Auditor of Vermillion County for deposit into Fund #1130, Prisoner Reimbursement for Incarceration.
