Whereas the Vermillion County Council, desires to establish a separated fund to which these monies and reimbursements are deposited when received by the auditor.


BE IT ORDAINED BY THE VERMILLION COUNTY COUNCIL OF VERMILLION COUNTY, OF INDIANA;


The monies in the fund can only be used to fund the operation of the county jail, including repairs, and improvements


Any monies remaining in the fund at the end of the year does not revert to any other fund, but remains in the county reimbursement fund for level 6 felony prisoners.


