A Resolution Involving Mileage Claims


Whereas it has come to the attention of the Board of Commissioners of Vermillion County that there exists a need for a resolution to the effect that mileage claims need to be turned in on a monthly basis, and the Board of Commissioners of Vermillion County resolves as follows:

1. That it has come to the attention of the Board of Commissioners of Vermillion County, Indiana that some county employees are waiting for months to turn in their mileage claims and/or turning in several months worth of mileage claims at one time. This practice places an unfair burden on the office processing those claims because older claims take more time and effort to process thus wasting taxpayer resources.
2. That Vermillion County employees who are allowed to submit mileage claims are instructed to turn them in promptly, within the next calendar month after those claims are incurred so as not to waste our taxpayers' resources.
3. That should the problem continue it will be addressed by the elected officials having oversight of those employees in order to avoid further waste of the taxpayer's resources.


