

COUNTY ORDINANCE NUMBER 2019-3  
Employee Direct Deposit Account Changes Ordinance  
Vermillion County, Indiana

AN ORDINANCE FOR EMPLOYEES THAT CHANGE OR CLOSE ACCOUNTS  
THAT AFFECT PAYROLL DIRECT DEPOSITS

WHEREAS, It has come to the attention of the Board of Commissioners of Vermillion County that a need exists to address employees that change or close bank accounts that affect payroll direct deposits.

Therefore the Board of Commissioners of Vermillion County by its inherent authority is creating this ordinance to address this issue.

NOW BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Vermillion County Commissioners that:

SECTION 1. This ordinance is intended solely for any employees that changes or closes any account that affects their payroll direct deposit.

SECTION 2. Any employee that does not notify payroll that they have closed or changed their direct deposit account will be charged a fee in accordance to the same fee charged by the bank.

SECTION 3. Any fee's received shall be deposited into the General Fund.

SECTION 4. Should any section, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase of this Ordinance be declared unconstitutional or invalid for any reason by any Court of competent jurisdiction, such provision shall be deemed severable and the remaining portions of this Ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 5. All ordinances or parts of ordinances or resolutions that are inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance are repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.
