

COUNTY ORDINANCE NUMBER 2019- 16  
Credit Card Ordinance  
Vermillion County, Indiana

AN ORDINANCE TO ALLOW THE PAYMENT AND REIMBURSEMENT OF  
CREDIT CARD CHARGES FOR THE VERMILLION COUNTY CIRCUIT COURT  
JUDGE

WHEREAS, It has been brought to the attention of the Board of Commissioners of Vermillion County that the Vermillion County Circuit Court Judge will apply for a business credit card through a local banking institution in order to make payments on purchases in a timelier manner. Additional documentation will still be required before such charges are paid.

NOW BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Vermillion County Commissioners that:

SECTION 1. Prior to reimbursing any credit card charges, the Vermillion County Circuit Court Judge seeking reimbursement must present a receipt showing sufficient detail of what was purchased to ensure that charge was in fact for the county.

SECTION 2. That the county may refuse to pay any credit card charge until sufficient documentation of the expense has been presented.



SECTION 3. Should any section, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase of this Ordinance be declared unconstitutional or invalid for any reason by any Court of competent jurisdiction, such provision shall be deemed severable and the remaining portions of this Ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.


