

ORDINANCE NO. 2020-4

BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF VERMILLION COUNTY

**AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE PURCHASE OF INFORMATION
TECHNOLOGY**


WHEREAS, the Vermillion County Board of Commissioners deems it vital to the safety of the people of Vermillion County that the information technology inside the courthouse remain as secure as reasonably possible. To that end the Board of Commissioners have undertaken to employ IT coordinators. Because there exists a number of Elected Officials, each of whom in accordance with the duties of their office must use the information technology inside the courthouse the Board of Commissioners of Vermillion County pursuant to their inherent authority under I.C. 36-2-2-24 to maintain the County Courthouse and offices for elected officials enacts this ordinance to regulate the purchase of information technology.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF VERMILLION COUNTY as follows:

1. This ordinance shall be known as the information technology purchase ordinance.
2. This ordinance is created pursuant to the Board of Commissioners' authority inherent under Home Rule and I.C. 36-2-2-24.
3. The Purpose of this ordinance is to regulate the purchase of information technology.
4. For purposes of this ordinance, Information Technology shall mean anything related to computing technology, such as networking, hardware, software, storage or phone systems that connects or may be connected to either the internet or the courthouse phone system.
5. Whatever individual, corporation or other entity that the Board of Commissioners shall designate as the county's IT Coordinator shall have final authority over the purchase of information technology. All information technology that is purchased to be used in the County Courthouse shall be done only with the prior approval of the IT Coordinator.
6. Inherent in their authority to regulate technology purchases shall be the authority to disconnect any piece of information technology that has been connected to the courthouse system without the prior approval of the IT Coordinator.
7. Should any section, provision, or part of this Ordinance be adjudged invalid or unconstitutional, such adjudication shall not affect the validity of the Ordinance as a whole, or any section, provision, or part thereof not adjudged invalid or unconstitutional.


