

COUNTY ORDINANCE NUMBER 2020-6
Closing the Courthouse and all County Offices Ordinance
Vermillion County, Indiana

AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING CLOSING THE COURTHOUSE AND COUNTY
OFFICES TO THE PUBLIC

WHEREAS, It has come to the attention of the Board of Commissioners of Vermillion County that a further need exists to address the potential spread of the COVID-19 virus for protection of the citizens of Vermillion County.

Therefore the Board of Commissioners of Vermillion County by its inherent authority and in accordance with the Governor's Executive Order is now extending the closing of the Vermillion County Courthouse and County Offices to the public.

NOW BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Vermillion County Commissioners that:

SECTION 1. The restrictions imposed on the Courthouse and County Offices by ordinance 2020-5 shall remain in effect until further notice.

SECTION 2. On Thursday, April 9th, 2020 the Courthouse shall be closed to everyone except EAS employees and the Courthouse Deputy. All other employees and elected officials are barred while EAS performs upgrades to the information technology inside the Courthouse. Courthouse Deputies are to enforce this ordinance.


SECTION 3. Should any section, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase of this Ordinance be declared unconstitutional or invalid for any reason by any Court of competent jurisdiction, such provision shall be deemed severable and the remaining portions of this Ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 4. All ordinances or parts of ordinances or resolutions that are inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance are repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.
