

COUNTY ORDINANCE NUMBER 2020-9
Closing the Courthouse Ordinance
Vermillion County, Indiana

AN ORDINANCE CLOSING THE COURTHOUSE JULY 2ND, 2020

WHEREAS, It has come to the attention of the Board of Commissioners of Vermillion County that an emergency need existed to close the courthouse on July 2nd, 2020 due to the failure of certain mechanical systems and the need to make repairs.

Therefore the Board of Commissioners of Vermillion County by its inherent authority closed the Vermillion County Courthouse to the public on July 2nd, 2020.

NOW BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Vermillion County Commissioners that:

SECTION 1. That the courthouse was closed due to an emergency and the need to make repairs to certain systems on July 2nd, 2020.

SECTION 8. Should any section, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase of this Ordinance be declared unconstitutional or invalid for any reason by any Court of competent jurisdiction, such provision shall be deemed severable and the remaining portions of this Ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 9. All ordinances or parts of ordinances or resolutions that are inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance are repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.
