## Ordinance 2020-11 **Vermillion County Council**

## **AUTHORIZING VERMILLION COUNTY TO JOIN THE** WABASH RIVER REGIONAL DEVELOPMENT AUTHORITY

WHEREAS, I.C. 36-7.6 allows each county and qualified city to join with one or more other counties and or qualified cities in order to establish a development authority;

WHEREAS, Vigo, Sullivan and Knox counties have previously joined to form a development authority to be known as the Wabash River Regional Development Authority; and

WHEREAS, the Vermillion County Council has determined that it would be in the best interest of the citizens of Vermillion County to join the Wabash River Regional Development Authority.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it ordained as follows:

- 1. Pursuant to I.C. 36-7.6-2-4, Vermillion County hereby joins the Wabash River Regional Development Authority ("Authority").
- 2. The Authority shall be managed by a Development Board ("Board") consisting of five board members ("Board Members"). Vermillion County's participation in the Authority shall be subject to the adoption of a resolution by the Board authorizing the County's membership in the Authority.
- 3. The appointment of the Board Members shall be determined by written agreement of the executives of the members of the Authority.

This Ordinance read, considered, and adopted by the Vermillion County Council on August 10, 2020, after unanimous consent to suspend the rules and adopt on the same day as its introduction.
